

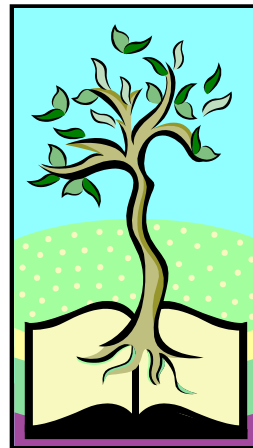
School Is In and the Word is Out....

It's an EMERGENCY! Or is it?



Bright Start Preschool administration and staff are highly trained and held accountable for the daily safety of all children in our care. Staff members are required to visually check every child upon arrival, for any unusual or new markings that may not have been present the day before.

Additionally, in the event of an accident during our daily activities, teachers are required to immediately notify the office and write up a Hurt and Hugs Report. Once reported to the office, the directors will contact a parent to give notice of the incident.

That being said, Kids are KIDS, and in any given situation an accident can occur, and the number one priority of our staff is to care and supervise our children in a loving and safe environment.

If a question or concern regarding your child arises AFTER business hours, and you truly feel it is an emergency, please DO NOT Facebook, Text, Instagram, or call the staff of BSP to ask questions, stop what you are doing, and take your child to the Emergency Room. If you do not feel, the concern is great enough to visit the Emergency Room, please wait until business hours to call the office and speak with the Director. Our directors will always exhaust all measures to ensure answers are available regarding your child.

As in any situation, we strive to be accessible to parents, however, we ask that parents respect our staff members by understanding that on any given day, with over 150 parents, time away from work should be allowed to be spent with their families. Upon our return to work, we will gladly assist you in any way possible.

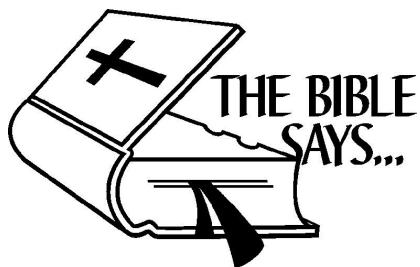
We simply ask that you truly look at the situations, and ask yourself

Parent Daily Reminders



- K-3 & K-4 are required to wear the assigned Daily Dress Code Every Day. New students have 2 weeks to be in complete uniform, however your child must wear a minimum the required bottoms and a white polo style shirt.
- Students must return their daily folder every day, signed.
- Every child must have a mat cover (which can be a large towel) and blanket for their personal use available to remain at the center (Teachers will keep them freshly washed)
- Every child must have in their cubby 2 sets of change of clothes (These clothes are not required to be uniforms) However they must be season appropriate and the child's size. Failure to maintain a change of clothes may result in calling the parents to deliver a change of clothes. Please help us, HELP you!
- **Tuition is Due the Friday before the week of services.** Late Fees are applied at Noon on Monday.
- Georgia Pre-K Hours are 8:00 AM—2:30 PM, any students remaining after 2:45 PM will be charged late pick up fees.

FALL CARNIVAL

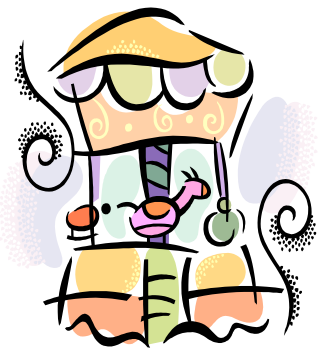
The Annual Fall Carnival will be hosted at Bright Start Preschool, 109 S Forrest Street, from 5:30 PM—7:30 PM.
